

## Embed a LinkedIn Post on a page

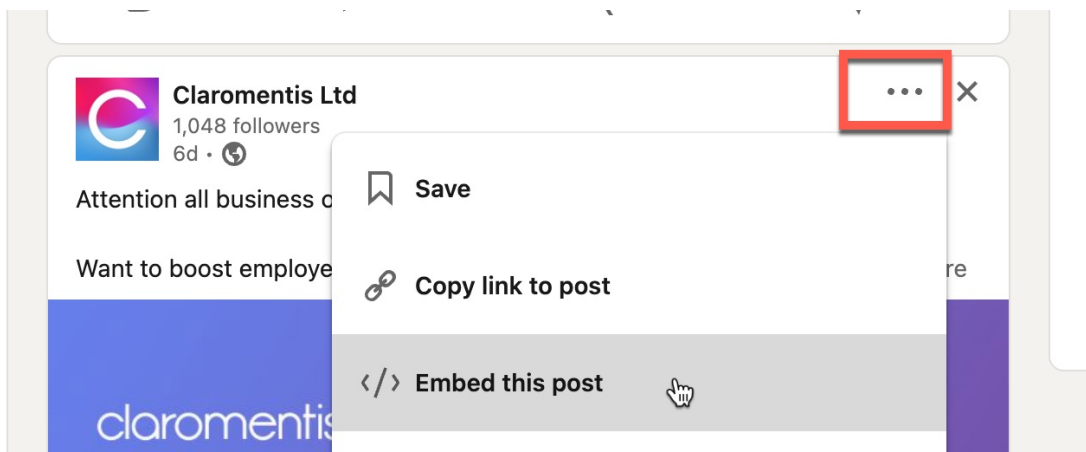
A whole feed cannot be displayed as the LinkedIn policy does not allow this; to get multiple posts on an Intranet page, use multiple embed components

### Step 1:

Navigate to the post you want to embed on LinkedIn.

### Step 2:

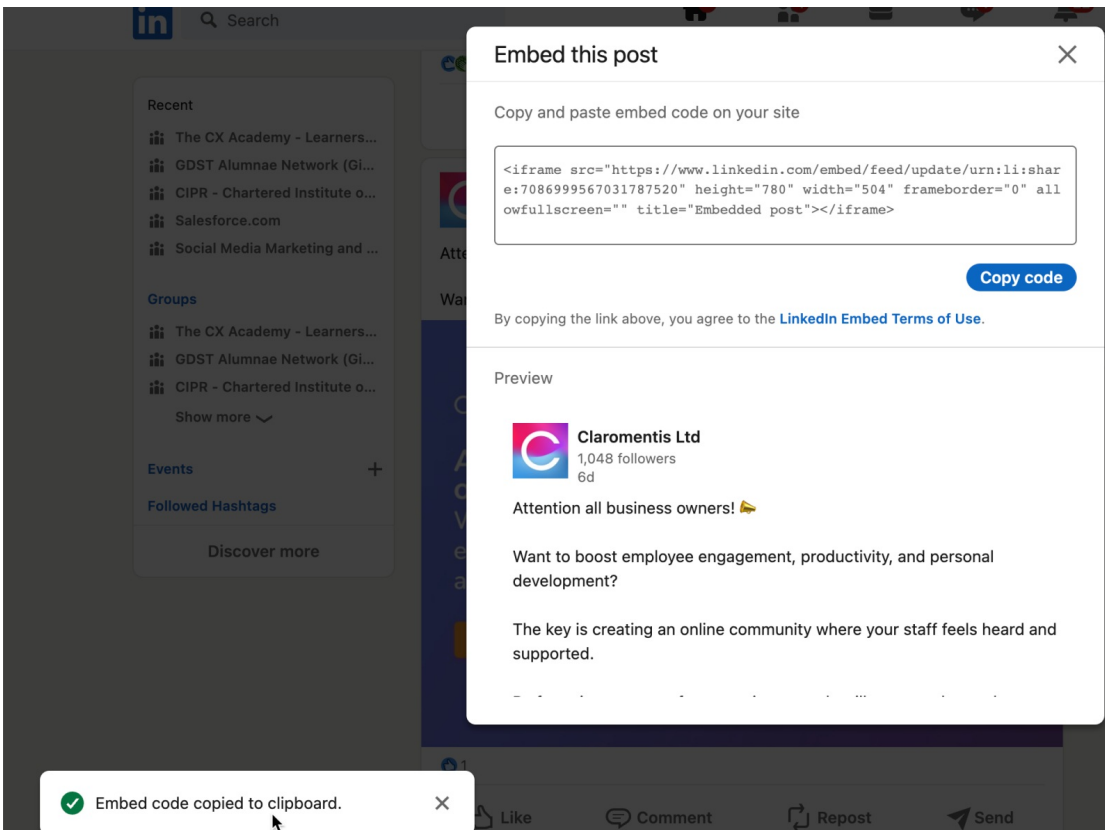
Click the 'More' icon in the top right corner of the post. and then click 'Embed this post'.



### Step 3:

Click **Copy code** from the pop-up window that appears.

You'll receive a notification in the bottom left corner of your screen telling you that the code has been copied to your clipboard.

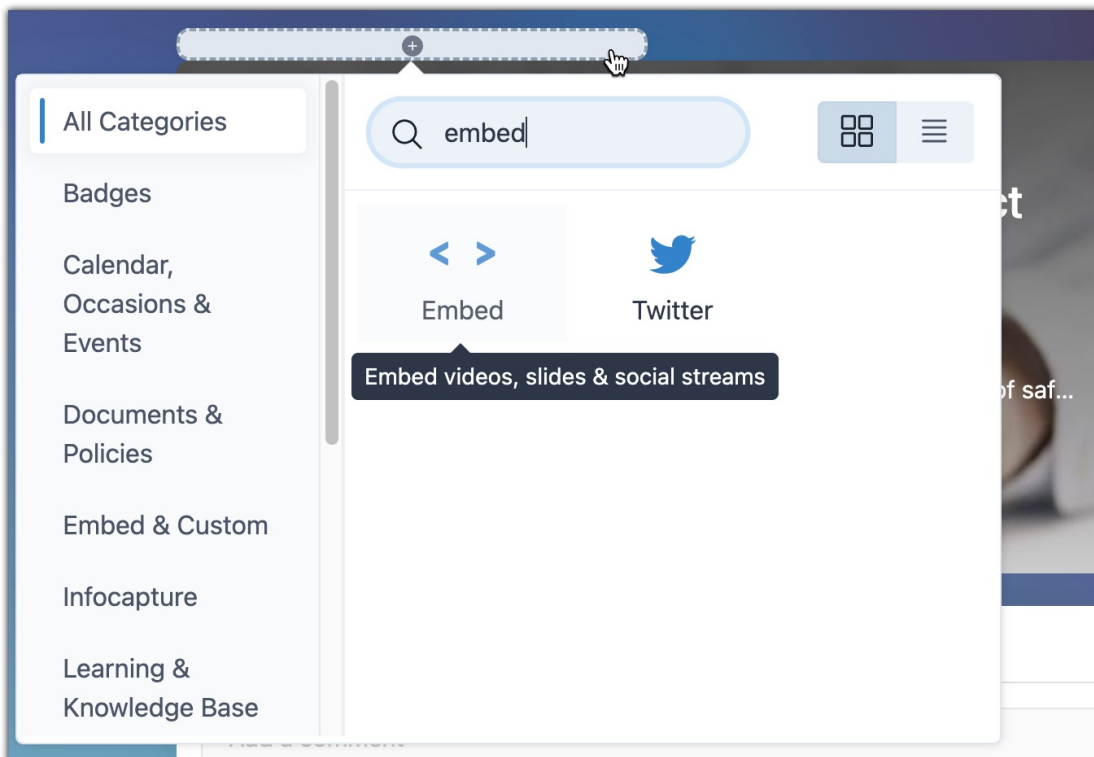


#### Step 4:

In Claromentis, [edit the page](#) you want to publish the post on.

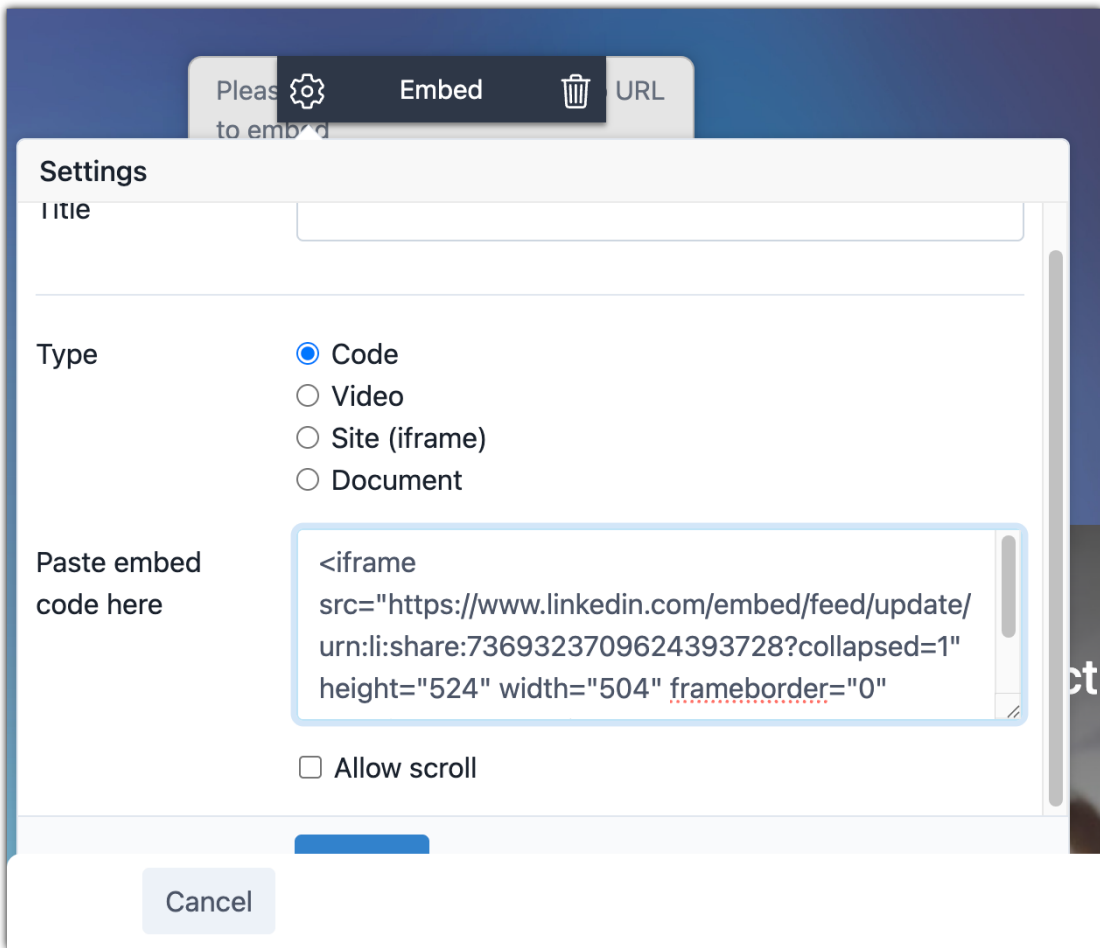
Click in white space to bring up the component menu.

Search for 'embed' and click on this to add it to the page.



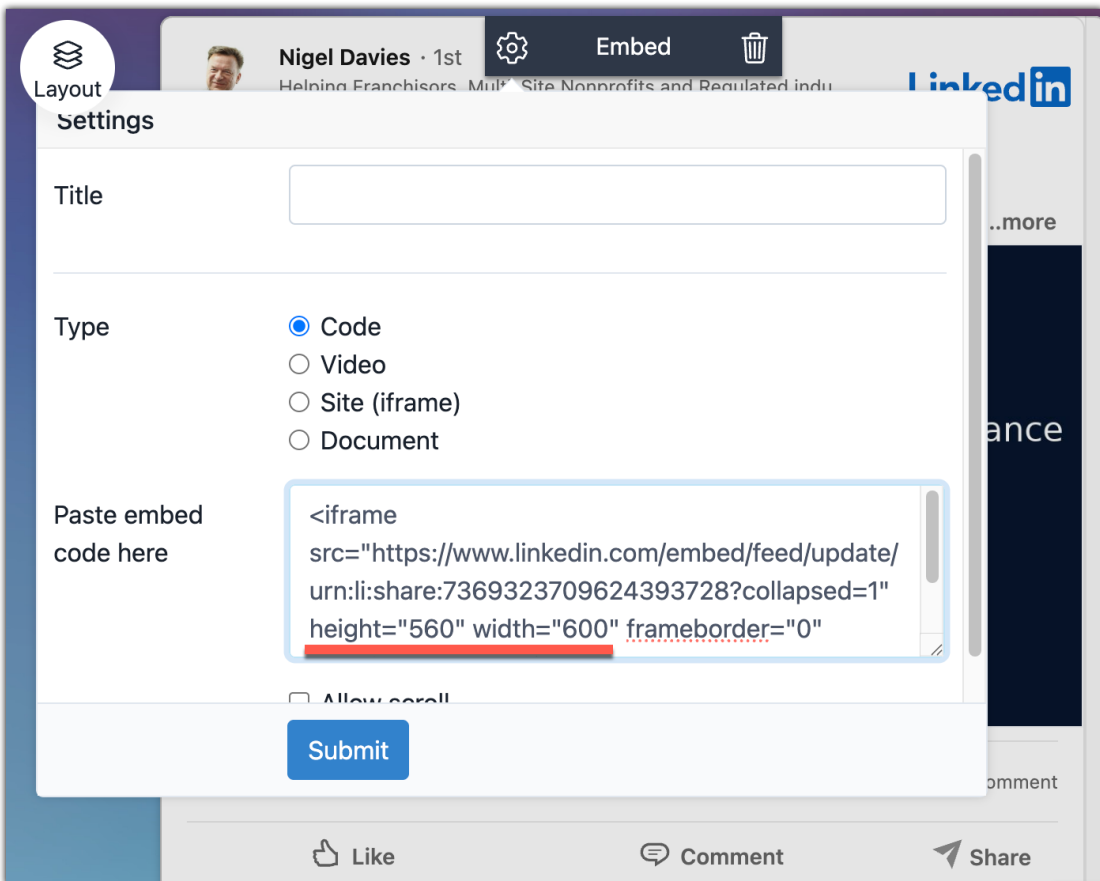
#### Step 5:

Paste the copied code from LinkedIn into the embed component 'code' type, and the post should pull through.



### Step 6:

In the code the height and width values can be manually edited to change the size of the post within the component to achieve the best fit.



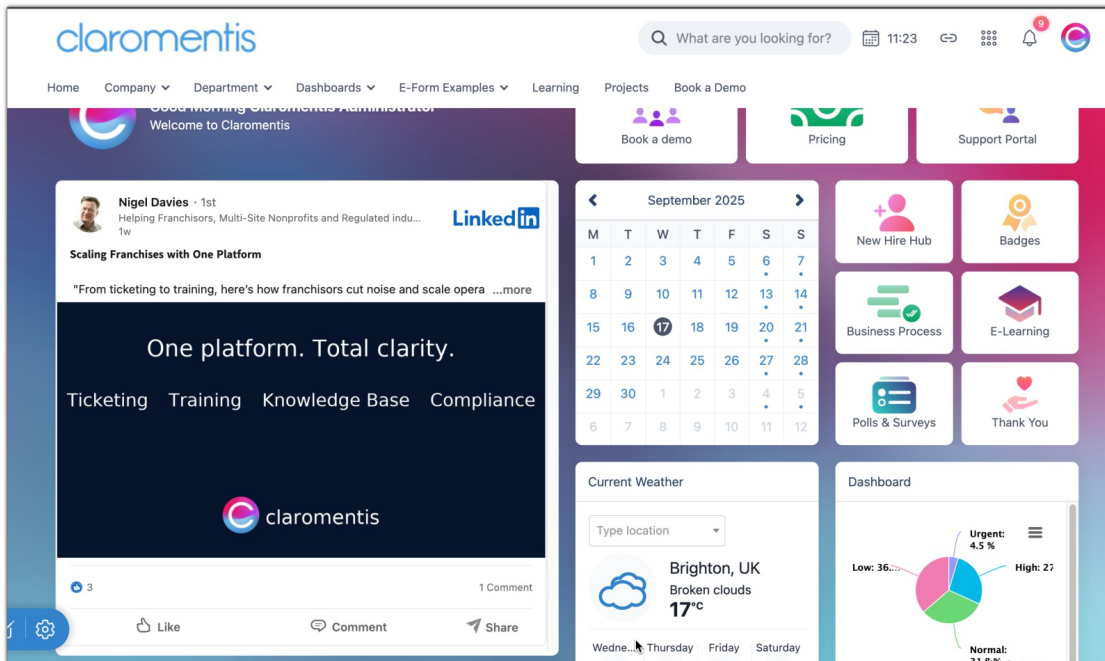
## Step 7:

Resize the component as required and tweak the height & width values further if needed, then publish your page to save changes.

## Step 8:

The post should be visible on the page.

More embed components can be added to host other posts as necessary.
