



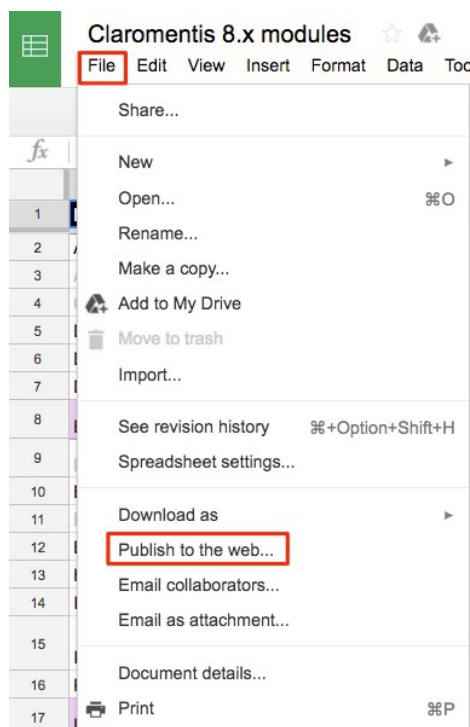
Embed Google Docs, Sheets or Slides to Pages

Overview

You can make a Google document, spreadsheet, presentation, or form available to view on a Page by using Embed component.

Step 1

1. Open a file in Google Docs, Sheets, or Slides.
2. At the top, click File and then Publish to the web.




3. In the window that appears, click **Link**.
4. Copy the link

Step 2

Using **Embed Component**, choose **Site (Iframe)**

Paste the link into web address field
