



Google Domain Verification

What is Google Domain Verification?

To protect you and your users, Google restricts your OAuth 2.0 application which is required when setting up Google API Integration on Claromentis using Authorized Domains. If you have verified the domain with Google, you can use any Top Private Domain as an Authorized Domain.

Step 1: Go to Google Webmaster Verification

<https://www.google.com/webmasters/verification/>

Click **Add Property**

and enter the URL you wish to verify which is the URL of your claromentis system for example

<https://workplace.claromentis.com>

Step 2: Download HTML verification file

Upload an HTML file to your site.

2. **Upload** the file to <https://superdemo8.claromentis.com/>
3. **Confirm** successful upload by visiting <https://superdemo8.claromentis.com/googlebdba1eef5578a319.html> in your browser.
4. **Click** Verify below.

To stay verified, don't remove the HTML file, even after verification succeeds.
