



## How to Add a Christmas Light Robe to a Theme

Add some Christmas festive cheer to your Intranet by adding a light robe to a theme for users to see:

## Steps

1. Navigate to Admin > Design and click on the theme you want to add the light robe to.
2. Click on Edit Style and then the Advanced tab:

4. Next, copy the below code and on your site scroll down and paste it into the **Custom Code** field:

5. Once both codes are pasted, click 'save' to apply this.

6. The light robe will now appear in that theme.

If you are not looking at the theme this was applied to, [switch to it](#) to check the lights appear.

7. Repeat for any other theme you want the robe to appear in.
