



## Google Play Store Requirements

### Why publish the custom app to Google Play Store?

There are some benefits to publishing your custom app through [Google Play Store](#)

- If your company does not have MDM (Mobile Device Management) solution, it is an easy way to distribute the app for Android phones.
- Is searchable in the Google Play app from mobile devices.
- Easy to install/update the app.
- Users will get automatic updates.
- Access to Google Play analytics can be granted.

There are some considerations:

- The app will be listed in Google Play publicly.
- You need to supply a dummy login for Google.
- Before the app can be published, the review process can take up to 7-14 days.

### What are the requirements?

If you wish to publish your custom app publicly to [Google Play](#) please send us the following information:

#### 1. App details

- App Name (max 50 characters)
- Short Description (max 80 characters)
- Full Description (max 400 characters)

#### 2. Link to your Privacy Policy (URL)

#### 3. App access
