



Create an Accordion in the Text Component

The Accordion code differs between versions 8 and 9+ of Claromentis. This article provides code for both versions and can be used as a reference point for updating the code

Overview

An Accordion can be used to show and hide content within the Pages Text Component.

Accordion Example

Please Note: Basic HTML and editing in Source Code is required to create and modify an Accordion.

How to

1. When editing a Page, add a **Text** component.
2. Go to the **Source** tab and then paste the following code as an example

Replace the the **highlighted** 'title' text (i.e. '**Title One**') with your title and the content body text (i.e. '**Text Content One**') with your text content.

Additional Sections

If you wish to use more than 3 sections in your accordion you will need to add another section inside the accordion wrapper after the other sections:

Below is the HTML code which makes up a section.

For each new section you need to add some unique attributes **highlighted below**. The easiest way to make the attributes unique is to give it the number of the section (e.g. **headingFour** for section 4, **headingFive** for section 5 and so on)

Multiple accordions on the same page

When placing multiple accordions on the same page give each accordion a unique ID. This will ensure that they work as intended:

- Add a new accordion to the page
- update the accordion wrapper ID to something unique e.g.

Claromentis v8

```

Claromentis v9+

```
<div aria-multiselectable="true" class="accordion" id="accordionTwo" role="tablist">
```

- update the 'data-parent' value on each panel title with the ID e.g.

Claromentis v8

```

  href="#collapseTwoOne" role="button">Title Two One </a>
</h4>

Claromentis v9+

  <button aria-controls="collapseTwoOne" aria-expanded="false" data-parent="#accordionTwo" class="btn btn-link
  btn-block text-left" data-toggle="collapse" href="#collapseTwoOne" role="button">Title One </button>
</h4>
```

- Ensure each section of the new accordion uses unique IDs not used in the existing accordion/s e.g. the IDs "headingOne" and "collapseOne" (see above) could be renamed as "headingTwoOne" and "collapseTwoOne" in the new accordion

Collapse all sections on page load

The default example above displays with the first section expanded but if you wish for it to be collapsed on page load then carry out the following steps.

In Section One replace:

```
aria-expanded="true false"
```

and remove:

```
class="panel-collapse collapse in"
```
